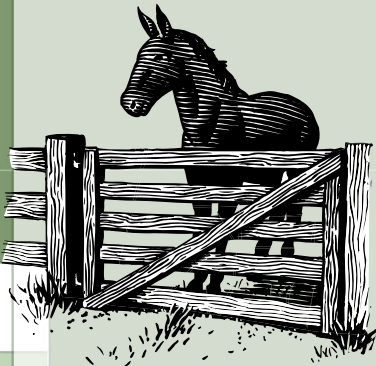

Travel While You Work



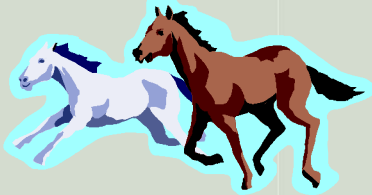
