Parallel Structure with Correlative Conjunctions

Incorrect:

You are either for us or you are against us.

Correct:

You are either for us or against us. Either you are for us or you are against us.

Incorrect:

Mary is neither a Democrat nor is she a Republican.

Correct:

Mary is neither a Democrat nor a Republican.

Incorrect:

The show is both enjoyable and it is educational.

Correct:

The show is both enjoyable and educational.

Incorrect:

The author not only wants fame but also money.

Correct:

The author not only wants fame but also wants money. The author wants not only fame but also money.

Parallel Structure with Lists

This is non-parallel, and must be changed:

I am responsible for:

- * editing copy
- * Supervised layout
- * I have three years experience as a news writer.

This is better, but emphasizes the number of years only in the last item:

I have:

- * Edited copy
- * Supervised layout
- * Spent three years writing news.

This is better but is still not completely balanced:

I have:

- * Edited copy
- * Supervised layout
- * Written news for three years.

These are much better:

I have:

- * Edited copy (one year)
- * Supervised layout (two years)
- * Written news (three years).

or

I have experience

- * editing copy (one year),
- * supervising layout (two years) and
- * writing news (three years).

Make the following lists parallel:
