

## Installing your ArcGIS 10.2 – Education Edition Software (license valid for one year)

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Mac users, make sure you have Windows before you start. If you don't, go here:

Window users follow the three steps below.

### Step I – obtaining authorization and installing the software

Fill out a form at: [http://www.geoplan.ufl.edu/software/student\\_license.php](http://www.geoplan.ufl.edu/software/student_license.php) and follow instructions for downloading and running the software. Pick Version 10.2, Advanced ArcInfo Single Use. Skip, if asked for extensions.

**Note:** the process is easy and straightforward, but be prepared to stay put for a while as it takes a long time.

### Step II – authorizing the software with the ESRI server

1. At the end of the installation process you will be asked to authorize the software. Go to: <http://www.esri.com/apps/Products/ArcGIS/ArcEdEval10/index.cfm?event=evaluate.index>
2. Create an ESRI global account or if you have one, just log in to it.
3. Authorize your software using the 12 digit code you received from the Geoplan that looks like EVA654786830.

### Step III – authorizing the software with your machine

1. Keep handy the same 12 digit code.
2. In Windows, go under: **Start/All Programs/ArcGIS/ArcGIS Administrator**.
3. On the top left side of the dialog select/highlight the folder **Desktop**.
4. On the right side under “**Select the software product...**”, make sure option **Advanced (ArcInfo) Single Use** is checked, and then press button “**Authorize now.**”
5. Follow Wizard's step by step instructions using your 12 digit code.
6. Skip screens about extensions, but if you installed any of them, just enter your *12 digit code* for each extension.

To open the software go under: **Start/All Programs/ArcGIS/ ArcMap10** and wait a bit. If no error warning message pops up, your installation has succeeded.
